Mr. Vogler has done some designs of residential homes and additions to homes in North Carolina and the surrounding area. Mr. Vogler has been in commercial construction since 1988. In 1991 he moved to Atlanta to work for a commercial architectural construction products company until 2000 when he moved to Texas. In Texas he worked for a construction and manufacturing software company until returning to Atlanta, Georgia in 2001. When he returned to Georgia he went back to working in the contracting and construction business and he currently works for a major glass and glazing contractor in Atlanta.

Mr. Vogler enjoys making detailed architectural sketches as a hobby utilizing various types of pencil grades on various paper formats. His techniques of drawing vary from formal architectural renderings to freehand sketches focusing on architectural design elements and details. He also has a very keen interest in genealogy, history, and enjoys participating in 19th century period living history events.
