She attended the University of Virginia and the University of Texas at Arlington. Peggy has always loved art and the move to Texas opened doors of opportunity to pursue that interest. She studied art and design at UTA, and has attended painting workshops by the following nationally known artists: Edward Betts, Edgar Whitney, Robert Wood, Al Brouillette, Charles Reid, Philip Jamison, Virginia Cobb, Carol Barnes, Ruth Wynn and Douglas Walton.*

*Since 1977, Peggy's original paintings in transparent watercolor and acrylics have been accepted in numerous local, regional, and national juried art shows. She has won several awards and earned signature status in the Southwest Watercolor Society. The signature status is awarded to an artist once they have five paintings accepted in the SWS annual juried show. Peggy met that criteria the first five consecutive years she submitted paintings to their competition.*

In 1987, full time employment with American Airlines put her painting on hold. Fourteen years later, she retired from American and returned to her first love, painting.
